



STEP 1




 Holding the syringe barrel near the top, insert needle/syringe vertically into the center hole at top of unit until it stops (see illustrations on back).



OUT SYRINGE NOT THE NEEDLE!

2. Hold **VOYAGER** securely with one hand above label area. With other hand, use steady pressure and SLOWLY twist the outside of the top to the right in the direction of the arrows (approx. 1/4 of a turn). Return the outside of the top back to the "Original Start Position".


STEP 3



3. Needle removal process is now complete. For safe transport and temporary closure, remove the cap from the bottom of the container and replace on top.

Dispose the remaining syringe barrel in household waste.

STEP 4



4. After contents reach the MAXIMUM FILL LINE - DISCONTINUE USE. Remove cap from the bottom of container and snap firmly onto the top of the VOYAGER.


